## May Day – the Bolton Way set for May 25

Saturday, May 25, will bring the opportunity for Bolton residents to enjoy a fun-filled day of music and live entertainment, food, space jumps, face paintings, a vendor fair, and much more.

From 10 a.m. until 4 p.m., May Day – the Bolton Way will take place at 130 Champion Hill Road (the old V.L. Reuben school). Billed as a family-friendly event, attendees are encouraged to bring tents, coolers and chairs to enjoy the festivities.

Because the event is a family event, no alcohol or weapons will be allowed. Additionally, grills are not permitted, as there will be multiple food vendors onsite. Security will be provided.

Vendors, sponsors and entertain-

ers are being sought for the festivities.

Informational vendors are those who do not sell products, but who provide written and/or verbal information. These vendors should bring their own setup, which can include a table and two chairs, to showcase materials, such as brochures and business cards.

Retail vendors should bring their own setup, limited to one table and two chairs, as well. If retail vendors need to bring an additional table, there is an option to add that during registration prior to checkout. Retail vendors can sell items such as clothes, shoes, purses and jewelry, but no edible items are allowed to be sold by a retail vendor.

Food vendors should also bring their own setup, limited to one table and two chairs. An additional table

option can be added during the registration process prior to checkout. The table-only food vendor option is not applicable to vendors who own food trucks or grills. Those who operate a food truck or grill should register as a food truck vendor and must bring their own equipment.

There will be no power sources for vendor booths, but generators are welcome.

All funds gathered from sponsorships will be allocated towards necessary event materials. Sponsors will have the chance to feature their business cards and/or sample products in the swag bags provided to vendors and guests. In addition, sponsors can join the event to promote their business, brand or product through announcements during the event,

as well as distribute flyers or other promotional materials. Sponsors may send fifty or more swag bag items to BossLadi Williams at P.O. Box 33, Bolton, MS 39041. All swag bag items must be received by May 1.

Vendor setup will begin at 8 a.m. on a first-come, first-assigned space basis.

The informational vendor booths are available for \$35, retail (non-food/drink) vendor booths are \$75, and food vendor booths for sweets, food and drinks are \$85. A limited number of food truck spots are available for \$100. Extra tables can be reserved for \$15, and sponsorship opportunities begin at \$50.
